


ShelterBox International Programmes Update

Emergency Response


PAKISTAN (flooding)

P1: To contribute to the self-recovery recovery process of **1,200 HH** (7,440 individuals) in flood affected Pakistan through timely distribution of appropriate **shelter and NFI assistance**.

P2: To contribute to the self-recovery recovery process of **5000 HH** in flood affected Pakistan through timely distribution of **cash assistance** and **NFI**.








PHILIPPINES (Typhoon Nalgae)

The typhoon affected nearly 6m people from 28 to 31 Oct, especially in parts of Mindanao where humanitarian access is difficult.

P1: Partnership between SBOP and IRDT to support the self-recovery of 1,212 HH in Zamboanga City through the distribution of shelter and NFI assistance.

ETHIOPIA (complex emergency)

Project 5:

Working with IOM to provide **12,000** Emergency Shelter and NFI packages to families displaced by conflict, insecurity and climate shocks.



MOZAMBIQUE (Cabo-Delgado conflict)

Project 2:

In partnership with CARE, to contribute towards the unmet need of vulnerable displaced households (HHs) in Mozambique through distribution of emergency shelter and NFIs to **6000 HHs** in Cabo Delgado.









SOMALIA (complex emergency)

Project 1

Establishing a response to meet the emergency shelter and household item needs of recently displaced people and to provide durable solutions to people living in protracted displacement.

Focus of the pilot project is on supporting people displaced by the drought.







BURKINA-FASO (conflict)

Project 4:

Supporting **1,000** newly displaced families – whose lives have been affected by violent extremism – with emergency shelter (known locally as 'Sahelian' tents) and other household items.





CAMEROON (conflict)

Project 11:

Proposal is to shelter approximately **9,800 HH**. Providing Tents and NFIs, Emergency Shelter and NFIs, Semi-Durable Shelter Kits and Rehabilitation Kits, and Durable Shelter Kits. Additional Community Tool Kits will also be provided.







SYRIA (civil war)

North-West (Winterisation) Project:

The Project will aim to reach **2000 HH** with a standard Shelter and HHI aid package as well as reaching **800** separate households with tent levelling support (tent bases) and tarps and ropes.

North-East (Winterisation) Project:

the Project will aim to reach **2000 HH** with a standard Shelter and HHI aid package.



UKRAINE – Phase 2 (conflict)

Project 4

To reach **2,000 households** with shelter and winter household items, and a smaller caseload of the most vulnerable (**approx.: 1,000 HH**) with stoves.

Project 5

YEMEN (civil war)

Project 2:

Plan to support internally displaced HHs in Marib with emergency shelter and HH items to improve living conditions and build resilience – in the context of the on-going conflict.
